Our experienced team is on hand from check-in through to check-out — booking, troubleshooting, and recommendations.



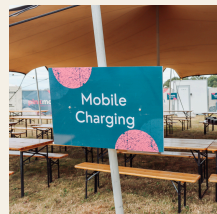
Pamper Parlour

24/7 manned security throughout build, show and break. Site access is for booked guests only.



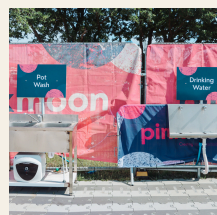
Onsite bar



THE CAMPSITE OPENING TIMES

Check-in and check-out times vary by event. Please visit your specific event page for full details.

Our reception is staffed 24 hours a day throughout your stay – whatever you need, whenever you need it.

EVENT OPENING TIMES

Site opening times for arrival and entry are to be announced nearer the event.

TRAVEL & PARKING

CHARGING FACILITIES

USB phone charging will be available throughout the site, with a phone charging pack rental on hand for guests who need extra power on the move. Please bring your own charging cable. More information to be announced.

TRAVELLING IN A GROUP?

Booking separately, but want tents pitched together? Book the same tent style under the same group name, and add the group name 12 weeks before the event.

HOUSE RULES

We pride ourselves on a safe, comfortable site. Please respect one another, the facilities and our team. The Ryder Cup has its own rules – check their [information page](#) for course-side requirements.

You're welcome to bring your own alcohol into the campsite – no glass bottles, please. A fully stocked on-site bar is also open daily across the event week. Please note that alcohol is not permitted on the course.

SECURITY

Site access is for booked campers only. Please zip up your tent when you leave and overnight.

BBQS & STOVES

BBQs are not permitted on site – including disposable BBQs. The on-site bar and food traders cover all your needs throughout the week. No naked flames are permitted.

QUIET TIMES

Between 11pm and 6am, please keep noise to a minimum. The course week is long – your neighbours will thank you.

SMOKING

No smoking or vaping inside tents or enclosed spaces.

Payment

Final payment is due no later than 12 weeks before the event. Cancellations more than 180 days before are subject to 25% of the total order value. Cancellations between 180 and 84 days are subject to 50%. Cancellations 84 days or fewer before the event are 100% non-refundable.

NEW TO CAMPING?

A few things we've learned from over a decade of running campsites, to help you enjoy every minute of your stay.

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE

Pack light, pack smart.

Check what your tent includes. Focus on layers, comfortable shoes, a waterproof jacket, and a refillable bottle. Irish September can swing from sunshine to evening chill in one day.

Check what's included.

Each tent type comes with different inclusions. Check your booking confirmation before you pack so you know what to bring and what's already waiting for you.

Charge everything.

Phones, headphones, power banks — charge them at home. USB charging is available throughout the site, but starting full saves you queuing later.

ON ARRIVAL

Find reception first.

Before you head to your tent, check in with our team. We'll hand over your wristband and answer the questions you didn't know you had.

Get your bearings.

Note your row, the nearest washroom, the route to the bar, and which way the course is. Much easier in daylight than after a long day on course.

DURING YOUR STAY

Zip up. Every time.

Zip your tent fully when you leave and overnight. It keeps your belongings secure and the weather out.

Keep valuables with you.

Take phones, wallets and watches when you leave the tent. Security is excellent, but tents aren't lockable like hotel rooms.

Layers, always layers.

Even warm days turn cool by evening. A hoodie or light jacket in your day bag saves a trip back.

Earplugs are your friend.

You're in a community of campers. An onsite bar, a few late conversations, an early-rising neighbour — earplugs make everyone a better sleeper.

Hydrate properly.

The walking, the standing, the celebrating. Hydration is the single biggest difference between a great week and a tough one. Refill at every water point.

GOOD TO KNOW

Showers.

Mornings are busiest. Mid-afternoon and late evening are quietest. Flip-flops recommended.

Night trips.

Keep a torch (or phone) by your bed and shoes by the door. You'll thank yourself later.

Cash & card.

The bar and food traders all accept card and contactless. You won't need cash.
